HAPPY NEW YEAR!!! I hope everyone had a great holiday season and are looking forward to the upcoming year. I know 2020 presented many challenges for each of us across the board, but I find myself being truly thankful that we were able to continue enjoying golf and the golf course.

For the maintenance operation, during the months of January and February our top priority is to prepare the golf course for play each morning. This takes about four hours and requires every staff member. Once the golf course is ready for play, work efforts will be focused on things such as, irrigation repairs, bunker repair (redistribute sand), tree work, and leaf removal. Much of this clean up and repair work is performed on a priority basis or "moments of opportunity." Also, the Department of Agriculture, after months of scouting and

planning will be on the golf course for the next several weeks removing trees that have been infected with the Asian long horned beetle. The majority of the work will be around holes 11,12,15, and 16. Furthermore, we will be planting trees and shrubs along property lines on holes one, two, and three softening the new neighborhood. GOLF INSTRUCTION BEN SLOAN

3 CHANGES TO BETTER STRUCK CHIP SHOTS

One of the quickest ways to improve your score is to improve short game. If you are one of those players that consistently chunk or thin those scoring shots around the green, then this article is for you! Lets get to it:

FIRST

Head centered over the golf ball with a small amount of shaft lean (from players perspective the butt end of the club should appear even with the golf ball). If you are looking to consistently hit the ball first it helps if your head is centered over the ball versus having it set up behind the ball.

SECOND

Narrowed Stance (4-5inches apart) and Pressure slightly favoring lead leg (Left leg for Right-Handed Player). For a shorter shot such as a chip or even a pitch we don't need to use our lower body for power so lets narrow up that stance and put a premium on solid contact. Keep about 55% of your pressure on your lead foot throughout the swinging motion.

THIRD

Momentum moving to the target. Picture yourself throwing a ball to a target. Where does the momentum of your body go? Well if you are throwing it accurately I would guess it's heading toward your target. Use that same visual on a chip shot.

If you can apply these 3 principles to your short chip and pitch shots around the green you will be well on your way to a more solid and consistent short game!

We have noticed

- We have noticed that there has been a golf boom courtesy of the pandemic.
- We have noticed that there are a lot more golfers at the Plantation Course.
- We have noticed that you golfers are getting better and hitting more greens in regulation.
- We have noticed the increase in ball marks on the greens.
- We have noticed that it got cold and our grass has gone dormant which significantly slows the recovery time for ball marks...Actually, we did not notice, we just "Know This".

As a result, we bought ourselves a couple of early Christmas gifts this year. They are called GreenStiks and they are used to repair ball marks. These handy little tools will get a workout this winter. Here is how they work...

The tool has spikes that extract when you push down on the ball mark at an angle. The ball mark is repaired by standing the tool vertical while the spikes are in the ground.







When the tool is lifted, the spikes retract, and a small amount of green sand drops out and into the repaired mark. The result is a smoother surface. Each repair only takes seconds!





While we do ask that everyone please repair your pitch marks on the greens, we now also have a tool that will aid in keeping the greens surfaces smoother year-round!

FROM THE DESK OF THE HEAD PROFESSIONAL SCOTT GLAZE

Happy New Year! I sincerely hope that you and yours have had a wonderful holiday season and are enjoying the club in the new year. As we enter 2021 and new endeavors at Stono Ferry, I want to touch on one of the biggest improvements we experienced in 2020: Visage GPS.

Last summer, we integrated the Visage GPS system in our brand new fleet of golf carts. After learning and adapting to the new system, we were able to learn things about pace of play on our golf course that we had never known through former practices. Pace of play is arguably one of the biggest concerns as we enter 2021. We experienced extremely high



volumes of golfers in 2020, occassionally putting a strain on pace of play. One of our new year's resolutions is to improve pace of play as we continue to have lots of traffic on our course. Visage GPS will help us to achieve this goal. After researching and digging through the data provided by Visage, we found some staggering statistics. For instance, golfers play pay par threes at Stono Ferry about 4 to 5 minutes faster than the recommended USGA pace settings. On the other hand, golfers play the par fives several minutes slower than the USGA recommendations. There were even a few par fours that averaged times that did not align with the former set pace at all. As a result, we have changed the "pace par" for many of the holes on the golf course, in order to provide accurate monitoring of pace on a daily basis. This will help us to identify problems on the golf course sooner and more accurately, thus addressing and fixing the issue before it gets out of hand. Here's to faster rounds in the new year!

Along with pace of play improvements, we were also able to see common traffic patterns and golfer behavior, which allowed us to make changes to our day-to-day operation as well as maintenance practices. This helps us to continue to provide a much better overall experience. (Remember, if you drive into a "restricted zone" it is only there to help keep the golf course in top-notch shape, not to be an inconv.) The convenience of ordering food and drinks from the comfort of your own cart has also been a great upgrade to the Stono Ferry experience. We will continue to tap into the many features and benefits of this great software system in 2021 and continue to provide one of the best golf and membership experiences in the Lowcountry.

As always, we greatly appreciate your feedback and insight on anything that enhances your membership here at the club. Please do not hesitate to let us know how we can serve you better.


