


PRO SHOP UPDATE STONO FERRY

Speaking of New Year's Resolutions, I am certain that all of us have few things we would like to improve when it comes to our golf games. Whether you want to shoot your lowest score, add a few yards to your driver, hole a few more putts, or accomplish all the above. It can all happen; however, it certainly does not happen overnight. My biggest recommendation is staying consistent. We find ourselves playing a game that is wildly inconsistent and as you know as soon as the ball leaves the club face is does not listen. When I talk about consistency what does that mean? Listed below are a few recommendations that you can pick and choose to implement that will lead you to enjoying the game more than you already do.

- Adapt a simple 15-minute stretching routine that elevates your heart rate. Your body will thank you and you have a better chance of putting a consistent strike on the ball.
- Pre-Shot Routine- Read the Lie, Wind, and play the high percentage shot. The focus on your Grip, Stance, Alignment, and Ball Position. Control what you can control- You will build confidence if you know your set up right you have that much better of a chance for a successful outcome.
- Forget about your score and focus on the task at hand. Golf is a game within a game. If you lose focus on what is in front of you 2 shots turn into 3 instead of turning 3 shots into 2.
- Make an appointment with a Golf Professional and manage your expectations.


