










decide to adjust the amount given or if you decide to not donate, please email

Golf Tip from Your Director of Instruction

I've had the privilege of coaching players at worldclass events like The Masters, The Players Championship, and The Solheim Cup. While we may not be playing on those stages, there's one powerful habit these top players share: they always keep the "main thing the main thing."

What does that mean? It's simple yet challenging. For every shot—whether it's a drive or a short putt—they focus on three essentials: Intention,

Commitment, Acceptance. Set a clear intention for each shot, commit fully to that plan, and then accept the outcome, whatever it may be. This helps them stay focused on the process rather than being distracted by results.

Try this approach yourself. By focusing on what you can control, you'll find the game more enjoyable, less stressful, and maybe even see your performance improve. Trust the process, let go of what you can't control, and watch your game—and your enjoyment—grow.

GRASS CLIPPINGS STONO FERRY

The golf course is just about prepared for the winter season. The overseeding of the tees, fairways, and driving range tees are complete. I want to thank you for staying on the path while we were trying to get it germinating and growing. We will continue to get it well established by cultural practices i.e., reseeding thin areas, height of cut, fertility levels, etc. Keep in mind that you will be playing on this grass through the month of May and into June of next year, so it is very important to follow the ruling of the day. This leads me into frost delays and frozen greens.

When frost occurs, the moisture inside the plant freezes, and if weight is applied to the plant while frozen it is damaged or killed with little or no chance for recovery. Frost usually forms when night temperatures are below 38 degrees Fahrenheit. If night time temperatures fall below freezing, the top one to two inches of any green are very susceptible to freezing. If play is allowed while the green is frozen, permanent damage

can, and will occur. Frost delays and frozen greens tend to encourage tense moments around the pro shop. I assure you; your golf course will be opened at the earliest possible moment the greens and overseeded areas are safe from potential harm.

During the months of November and December the maintenance staff concentrates on keeping the course ready for play. Managing falling leaves, and care of the winter grass are top priorities. The maintenance crew and I hope your holiday season allows for some memorable family times and a chance to play the course often. As always may your drives be straight and your putts short!

Keep an eye out for our **Annual Christmas Sale** — it is just around the corner!





I have been on the golf maintenance side of the business for almost 16 years. It started in Grand Rapids, Michigan as a crew member trying to find a job in my degree for business. I instantly fell in love with golf course maintenance, so I decided to go back to college for a Turf degree. My wife and I decided to move to Walterboro 14 years ago and I began working at Cherokee Plantation and stayed there for almost 13 years. Over the next few months, we will continue working on the irrigation system to get it working flawlessly by spring. Also, we will be concentrating on little details this winter such as trimming trees and landscaping around the course. We will also be transplanting some grasses around some bunkers under trees.
