Michael Eargle and his team are focusing on cart path repairs, applying spring fertilizers and pre-emergents, and adjusting grass heights to encourage bermudagrass growth as it breaks dormancy. At Edisto, Joe Hill's crew is performing similar preparations, including verticutting and topdressing greens and tees. These efforts will ensure optimal playing conditions as temperatures rise.


KICK OFF THE GOLF SEASON AT STONO FERRY!

The holiday season has officially passed, so I hope everyone is staying with their resolutions! During the months of March and April we will continue to work on preparing the golf course for the upcoming golf season. This includes, repairing areas along the cart path, fertilizing with Spring pre-emergent, replenishing mulch beds, and focusing in on day-to-day golf course maintenance. Also, it is the time when heights of short grass areas start going down. On the overseeded areas (tees and fairways) this is done to allow more sunlight to get into the canopy which allows the bermudagrass to get going. On the non-overseeded areas (greens, collars, and approaches), we do this to start training the growth as it comes out of dormancy to allow for tighter lies.

Spring also brings new flowers throughout. Trees begin to bud and the bermuda grass finally breaks dormancy. So, let us take advantage of the nice days ahead to enjoy a wonderful round of golf or to practice your swing at the driving range. Do not forget to repair those ball marks!!!

- When booking your tee time, please reserve for the number of players who will be playing. For example, if you consistently book a foursome but only two players show up, it can create challenges for others.

GRASS CLIPPINGS PLANTATION COURSE

Spring is just around the corner!!! After a long and chilly winter, our maintenance staff is looking forward to warmer days ahead—and we hope you are too.

This spring, several key maintenance practices will be taking place to ensure the course is in top shape for the growing season. Over the next couple of months, you can expect some Cart Path Only days as we apply fertilizer and pre-emergent. March and April are crucial months for preparing the turf, so we'll also be lightly verticutting and topdressing greens, as well as topdressing tees to help them recover from winter play. As temperatures rise and conditions dry out, we will begin removing rope stakes around the course. Please continue using the black markers in the fairways for driving on and off.

With the return of warmer weather, the grass will start growing at a faster rate, requiring more frequent mowing. If you see a staff member mowing on a path, please allow them to finish the path and they will move out of your way. Safety is a top priority, and we want to ensure no one is put at risk of being hit by a golf ball.

We're also excited to share that you'll soon notice expansions in short grass and landing areas—stay tuned for these enhancements!

Finally, a big thank you to everyone who helped with sanding divots throughout the winter. Your efforts make a big difference in keeping the course in great shape! As always, we appreciate your continued support in repairing divots and ball marks.

Don't hesitate to stop by and say hello if you see us out on the course—we're looking forward to a fantastic spring season.
