As the fall golf season approaches, I want to thank the membership for your patience as we continue working on improvements to The Links at Stono Ferry in 2025.

Completed Projects: We have successfully completed several key improvements this year, including raising and regrading the chipping green (\$20,000), installing a new sod-face practice bunker at the Learning Center end of the range (\$52,000), upgrading the outdoor bar area on the gray deck (\$20,000), installing curbing around cart paths (\$10,000), and completing sodding repairs on holes 7, 11, 12, 13, 15, and 17 (\$25,000). We are currently in the process of installing laser-leveled and newly sodded green tees on holes 6, 8, 9, 10, and 18 (\$25,000).

Upcoming 2025 Projects: Work remains on completing the new artificial teeing area on the driving range (\$62,000), with a target completion date of September 12. The new tee line allows players to alter the teeing height to their preference, eliminating the need to hit balls in front of the teeing area. This feature will provide a safer place to practice and eliminate the worn turf issues in front of the teeing area. Beginning September 8, we will lower the grade of the maroon tee on hole 6 to match the gold tee elevation, using the excess soil to widen the



tee. Once widened, we will laser-level and sod the entire area (\$20,000). Later this year, we have planned cart path repairs (\$50,000).

Major Infrastructure Investment: Irrigation is the lifeblood of any golf course, and I'm excited to announce a comprehensive irrigation system upgrade beginning late 2025 and early 2026. This \$657,000 investment will feature a new Toro system with updated irrigation heads and controls, new irrigation loops around each green, and GPS mapping technology to ensure precise water application. This upgrade will deliver better conditions on greens, fringes, and surrounding rough, plus more consistent greenside bunkers. Best of all, the course will remain open during installation.

Our goal is to provide exceptional and consistent course conditions year-round. Thank you for your continued support of The Links at Stono Ferry.

# GRASS CLIPPINGS STONO FERRY

It is hard to believe that Fall is approaching fast! As we progress further into the year, the course will see major changes. Along with the tee box renovations that are currently taking place, I am excited to announce that we will begin an upgrade of our irrigation system starting in November and weather permitting should take approximately 90 days to complete, with no disruption of play. Water management is the most crucial part of maintaining and improving the

overall quality of turf, and this upgrade will be an enormous step towards achieving this goal.

Phase I of this project began approximately three years ago when we upgraded our pumping station, which is the heart of the system, to a modernized system that replaced the unreliable mechanical aspects. Overall, it has made this part of the system more dependable with

consistent flow of water, and fewer mainline leaks.

Phase 2 of this project, which will begin in November will consist of replacing every irrigation head, rewiring the system, adding new greens loops with directional heads, and integrating new software that will allow each individual head to be controlled. This individual head control is huge! Currently the system heads are programmed to operate in two, three and sometimes four heads per station. This lack of individual control has made irrigating the golf course incredibly challenging. Due to the current systems limitations, we are forced to program irrigation in a way that creates uniformity issues such as overwatered and underwatered areas, which has a negative impact on the game.

This new upgrade is extremely expensive and lacks the wow factor because everything is underground and you do not see it. However, what you will see, and notice are firmer approaches and greens surrounds, firmer greens with less ball marks. Overall healthier, more consistent turf throughout property.

In October, We will overseed the tees and fairways with ryegrass. Overseeding provides defined landing areas, desirable year-round color and protection for the permanent bermudagrass. To ensure a successful winter crop, please keep carts (including pull carts) on the path and off of tee tops. Until after first mowing-usually about a week after seeding date. Looking ahead, the maintenance team will continue to focus on keeping the course in top condition for winter play. We encourage you to enjoy the beautiful fall weather and play as often as you can!

Hello Golfers,

As we wrap up a hot and humid summer, we're excited to kick off our fall tournament season!

Michael and his crew have done a tremendous job restoring the course after a tough winter and spring, and it's now shaping up to deliver both beauty and challenge for the months ahead.

As many of you know, Stono Ferry continues to offer a true test from every set of tees. In my opinion, it's one of the toughest tracks in the Lowcountry at the yardages we play — and recent updates to our course and slope ratings confirm that. In fact, every tee and combination set has come back with higher ratings than before.

#### Here's why:

- SCGA Review & Data: Since the Playing Conditions Calculation (PCC) system was introduced in 2020, Stono Ferry has consistently registered adjustments of +1 to +3. This means our course has been playing tougher than previous ratings reflected.
- Changing Conditions: Wind patterns, rough height, and green speeds (stimp) have all increased since our last rating in 2018 — or were undervalued at that time.
- Updated Rating Methods: The latest system places more weight on features like penalty areas, especially for bogey golfers. This has notably impacted slope ratings on longer tees.

These changes mean our challenge is now more accurately reflected on paper — something many of us have felt in practice for years.

# **TOURNAMENT NEWS**

The WGA and MGA Club Championships are set for September 13–14, and both Associations are expecting record turnouts. It promises to be another exciting weekend of fun and competition.

Don't miss the MGA's Friday Night Championship Social from 5–9pm on September 12, the evening before the Club Championship. We'll also host the Final Four Match of the MGA President's Cup, starting at 12:30pm. Each player will compete in three simultaneous matches, with scoring as follows:

Win a hole: 1 point
Halve a hole: ½ point

The top two players (and ties) after 18 holes will advance to a shootout on hole 18, scheduled for approximately 5:15–5:30pm. Come out and cheer them on!


